Maternal and Infant Community Health Collaboratives

Available in: Jefferson, Lewis & St. Lawrence Counties

Education and Outreach

Our staff is available to provide maternal, infant, and reproductive health presentations on a variety of topics. Presentations are available to parents, community members, students, businesses, and health and human service providers.

Community Health Worker (CHW) Program

This program offers home visiting services to women of childbearing age. The CHW program provides peer support before, during, and after pregnancy to promote overall health and wellness. Community Health Workers link individuals with health care providers, social services, and community resources to improve access to services and coordination of care. CHWs also offer baby weight checks.

Breastfeeding Support

We are dedicated to making breastfeeding an easy choice for infant feeding. Contact us for information on Certified Lactation Counselors and breastfeeding groups.

Gouverneur Activity and Learning Center Available in: Gouverneur Community

The Gouverneur Activity and Learning Center offers a healthy, warm, welcoming, family-oriented center that encourages parents to drop in for companionship, peer discussion, and positive social support, as well as field trips and free play for children.

Healthy Families Jefferson County Available in: Jefferson County

Healthy Families is an evidence-based, accredited parent support and early intervention program that promotes health and development starting at the most effective time: with expectant parents and parents of babies under three months of age. Healthy Families offers strength-based, trusting, voluntary, long-term, home-based partnerships between the Family Specialist and parents from as early as the first trimester of pregnancy until the child reaches school age. Services are provided at no cost to the family.

Health Insurance Assistance

Available in: Jefferson, Lewis & St. Lawrence Counties

Navigators offer help in applying for health insurance on the New York State of Health Marketplace including year-round enrollments for Medicaid, the Essential Plan, and Child Health Plus. Open enrollment for Qualified Health Plans typically begins in November. Navigators also assist in locating providers and pharmacies that work with insurance plans and education on topics such as co-pays, deductibles, and co-insurance. Navigators make frequent referrals to other programs both within and outside NCPPC.

Community Health Advocates

Available in: Jefferson, Lewis & St. Lawrence Counties

Community Health Advocates provide one-on-one assistance and community trainings about health insurance and access to health care. They can assist people with back medical bills, finding providers, affordable prescription drugs, and other issues.

Population Health

Available in: Jefferson, Lewis & St. Lawrence Counties

Community Health Worker (CHW) Program

The Population Health program offers home visiting services to adults aged 18 and older experiencing a chronic illness. The CHW program provides peer support to improve health literacy, patient care, and chronic illness self-management. CHWs assist with health care, social services, and community resources to improve access to and coordination with providers. The CHW collaborates with the client to improve their quality of health while reducing ER visits and admissions or readmissions to the hospital.

Youth Services

Comprehensive Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention (CAPP)

Available in: Jefferson & St. Lawrence Counties

The CAPP program focuses on pregnancy prevention and the promotion of sexual health among adolescents age 10 to 21, including those pregnant and parenting, with a focus on high risk and disconnected youth served through local community projects. Programs include Be Proud! Be Responsible!, Making Proud Choices, Safe Dates, Girls Circle, and Me Too!.

The YEAH! Program

Available in: Lewis County (Lowville Area)

The YEAH! Program provides comprehensive sexuality education in the Lowville school district, one on one support for students at risk of pregnancy, relationship and boundary setting education for special needs youth, and a range of youth development activities. Activities and support services are intended to increase access to new opportunities and help young people make healthy choices.
